



## HURRICANE IAN – GRANT OVERSIGHT, COMPLIANCE, & EXPERTISE

In the wake of the most destructive event to strike Charlotte County since Hurricane Charley in 2004, Charlotte County Public Schools engaged Synergy Disaster Recovery to provide grant management services for nearly \$200 million in damages.

Through the innovative Insurance Managed Repair Program (IMRP) under FEMA Public Assistance, Synergy coordinated the administration of millions of dollars in FEMA-eligible funds, setting a new standard for how the State of Florida and FEMA executes projects under this program.

Beyond compliance and coordination, Synergy also secured additional funding that reduced the district's out-of-pocket costs to nearly zero, ensuring critical recovery with minimal financial burden on the schools.
